

Propitiation Review Sheet 09 February 2020

How did we arrive at our definition of Propitiation? The aid of the Holy Spirit, a knowledge of the English meaning of propitiation, a knowledge of the gospel, and faith in the integrity and trustworthiness of the Bible is enough.

- **There is an OT and a NT** (Hebrews 9:15).
- **These two are not the same** (Hebrews 7:22; 8:7).
- **One difference is between OT and NT forgiveness** (Hebrews 10:1,2, 10-12).
- **OT forgiveness wasn't finished or completed** (Hebrews 10:4, 8:8, 12)
- **In the NT forgiveness is eternal and complete** (Hebrews 9:26).
- **Propitiation is the complete satisfaction** (or satisfier, Greg's perspective) of God's holiness, justice, and righteousness.
 - "He (Jesus) IS THE PROPITIATION" I John 2:2, whole world
 - He is the FULL PAYMENT. (None of these definitions can capture the complete truth of the matter. The truth is HUGE.)
- **Propitiation (complete satisfaction) only occurred** when Jesus Christ came into the world and died and rose for sins. (Christ's death propitiated for the OT sins as well, Hebrews 9:15)
- **I believe the word propitiation is only found in the NT** to illustrate that propitiation never occurred in OT (Romans 3:25, I John 2:2; 4:10).
- **Jesus Christ came into the world to finish Atonement** and take away the sins of the world (make propitiation) (John 1:29; John 19:30).

- **OT temporal forgiveness is termed remission** in the Scripture. Remission always refers to an OT temporal forgiveness. God is remitting the worlds sins right now under the Old Covenant. The reason why America and every other nation including Israel still stands is because God is remitting sins, but they're not taken away and America needs to repent and believe the gospel.
