

ATONEMENT

- 1. To make reparation or amends for a sin, offense, or injury.**
- 2. Atonement is the process of being reconciled or made at-one with another.**

Leviticus 17:11

For the life of the flesh *is* in the blood:
and I have given it to you upon the
altar to make an atonement for your
souls: for it *is* the blood *that* maketh an
atonement for the soul.

BLOOD ATONEMENT

The term and idea refer primarily to the book of Leviticus.

Leviticus teaches these four things clearly:

- 1. God has a way of dealing with sinful man.**
- 2. He reveals how he deals with man in a book.**
- 3. God deals with sinful man through blood atonement.**
- 4. Outside of this way, there is no other way.**

Why does God require a blood atonement?

1. Maybe the blood is corrupt
2. Maybe to teach that all bloodshed is a result of sin.
3. Maybe to teach that sin costs man's life.
4. Maybe because sin caused man's first bloodshed.
5. Maybe because man's first sin involved blood.
6. Maybe because sin affected man's blood.
7. Maybe to typify God's sacrifice for man.

BLOOD ATONEMENT

1. Blood Atonement is the sacrifice (reparation) required for the soul.
2. Blood Atonement is the fulfilling (satisfaction) of the law for sin.
3. Blood Atonement is the process of being reconciled to God. It makes things right between God and man.

BLOOD ATONEMENT (Leviticus 17:11)

- Blood atonement is God's way of dealing with sin.
- Blood atonement is the requirement of God for sin.
- Blood atonement is God's way for man to approach Him.
- Blood atonement is the way of reconciliation or restoration of friendly relations between God and sinners.

- **Blood atonements were different in the OT and NT.**
- **OT Blood atonements only temporarily satisfied the demands of the broken Law.**
- **OT Blood atonements only temporarily secured forgiveness, cleansing, and reconciliation for sin.**
- **Christ's NT Blood Atonement is that which fully satisfies the demands of the law and the Judgment of God.**
